True Weather Data regarding Las Vegas in July!

Here is some information regarding Las Vegas temperatures in July. BCAPL/CSI put this together to assist in answering questions about summer heat in Las Vegas.

We have heard some very untrue comments about summer temperatures in Las Vegas, like "It gets up to 120-130 degrees every day." Wrong. It has never reached 120 in Las Vegas (although it has in other parts of Nevada).

Different web sites give different numbers ... sometimes very different. For example, the record low temperatures I have found for Las Vegas range from 40 to 56 degrees. Here is a reliable average of the information available:

Las Vegas:	July
Average high	104
Average temp	89
Average low	75

Notes:

- Desert temperatures drop quickly after the sun sets and the evenings are very comfortable.
- Humidity greatly increases the "heat index," or how hot the air feels to your skin. It feels just as hot to most people when the temps are in the 80s in a state or province with extreme humidity, as it does at 104 degrees (the average high) in Las Vegas with low humidity.
- All pool competitions will be staged in the beautiful Rio convention center, where the temperatures are always just right.

Please familiarize yourself with all the activities Vegas has to offer, bring the family, and make this inaugural event one to remember.
